Dear Parents and Carers,

We would like to send a gentle reminder about our morning start routines, as these are an important part of helping your child settle quickly and begin their day positively.

- Gates open: 8:40am
- Gates close: 8:50am (doors will be locked promptly)

From this time, children will move straight into their key worker group activities Start of the day activity (SODA)—a calm, engaging start to the day designed to support routines, relationships, and readiness for learning. It is always exciting to see how well the children respond to these sessions.

Our children with Special Educational Needs and/ or Disabilities (SEND) will also begin their focused group activities during this time, ensuring they have the right support in place from the very start of the day.

If your child arrives after 8:50am, they will be supported in the reception area by yourselves, as parents, until the initial 9:00am activities are completed, before joining their class. This change is being implemented to avoid disrupting the learning of other children.

We completely understand that mornings can sometimes be challenging, and we appreciate your efforts in supporting these routines. Arriving on time really helps your child to “hit the ground running”, feel settled, and fully access their exciting learning journey.
