Covid-19

A reminder that pupils are not permitted to attend school if they have any of the following symptoms.

- a high temperature (37.8 degrees+);
- a new, continuous cough – this means coughing a lot, for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours;
- a loss or change to sense of smell or taste – this means they cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal.

If your child, or any member of your household experiences any of these symptoms, they must have a PCR test – not just a LFD test.

Please inform school immediately if your child has a positive test for Covid-19.

They do not need to self-isolate if the test is negative. As soon as your child is well enough, they may return to school.

An important reminder that if any member of your household displays Covid-19 symptoms they must seek a test; your child is not allowed to attend school whilst the household member is awaiting the test result.

If the test result is negative, your child may return to school. However, if it is positive, your child must self-isolate for 10 days from the household member's onset of symptoms. Your child and family also have to self-isolate for 10 days if any family member has a positive Lateral Flow test result.
